Modesty Statement

At Susque we strive to convey a mindset of Christian modesty. To help accomplish this, we ask that clothing cover undergarments and private areas. Shirts should also be long enough to cover the midriff area.

A Note on Cotton

It is important to bring clothing that helps you stay warm and dry. Therefore, we ask you to avoid bringing cotton clothing and bedding. This includes jeans, t-shirts, sweatpants, and sweatshirts. Quick-dry, wicking fabrics such as polyester, fleece, and wool are best.

Clothing

- 2 lightweight shorts
- 1 pair lightweight pants
- 2-3 t-shirts
- 1 long-sleeved shirt
- 1 warm fleece or jacket
- Underwear
- Socks for hiking (*Not needed for CC or DRR.*)
- Hiking boots/shoes that are broken in (*Not needed for CC or DRR.*)
- Aqua shoes or sandals you can swim in
- Modest swimwear
 - Boys: Loose-fitting shorts
 - Girls: One or two-piece that covers that midriff area
- Warm pajamas and socks
- Rain gear
- Hat that won't blow off easily
- Clean clothes to be left at Susque for your return

Personal Items

- Towel
- Bio-degradable soap & soapbox
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Travel-size deodorant
- Comb/brush
- Headlamp/Flashlight with batteries
- Medications (*Must be in original containers, including over-the-counter. These will be turned into the Camp Nurse upon check-in, so have them easily accessible.*)
- Toiletries
- Non-aerosol bug repellent
- Sunscreen
- 2 personal water bottles (*required*)
- Whistle
- Sunglasses
- Pocket Knife
- Backpack-big enough to hold all of your stuff. Everything must fit into 1 bag.
- Ziploc & garbage bags to keep things dry
- Pen or pencil
- Small notebook
- Bible
- Small amount of \$ to buy snacks during travel time

Bedding

- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping Pad (*Camp can lend this item.*)

What Not to Bring

- Playing cards
- Fireworks
- Make-up
- Flip flops
- Aerosol Cans (*including deodorant and hair spray*)
- Electronics (*Cell phone, personal music device, tablet, e-reader, portable game system*)
